We have many children in our neighborhood and more children are outside playing. Please slow down on our roads to keep our children safe. The clubhouse parking lot is no exception - please slow down when entering because we have children at play.

Their newest safety guide is to never leave your child alone in a car. With the heat rising, nearly a third of the heat-related fatalities with children occur when a child slips away unnoticed and gets into a car, getting heat stroke or hyperthermia. To keep children safe:

- \* Drivers should always lock car doors and trunks, regardless of the situation.
- \* Keys should be kept away from children.
- \* Children should not be allowed to play in cars.
- \* When a child is missing, vehicles and trunks should be checked first.
