DO YA

FIRE PREVENTION MONTH

- Always use cooking equipment tested and approved.
- Never leave cooking food on the stovetop unattended, and keep a close eye on food cooking inside the oven.
- Keep cooking areas clean & clear of combustibles (e.g. potholders, towels, rags, drapes & food packaging).
- Keep children away from cooking areas by enforcing a "kid-free zone" of three feet around the stove. Keep pets from underfoot & off cooking surfaces.
- Wear short, close fitting or tightly rolled sleeves when cooking.
- Never use a wet oven mitt, as it could present a scald danger .
- Always keep a potholder, oven mitt and lid handy. If a small fire starts in a pan or the stove, put on an oven mitt and smother the flames by carefully sliding the lid over the pan. Turn off the burner. Don't remove the lid until completely cool. Never pour water on a grease fire & never discharge a fire extinguisher onto a pan fire, as it can spray or shoot grease, actually spreading the fire.
- In an oven fire, turn off the heat & keep the door closed.
- In a microwave fire, keep the door closed & unplug. Have it serviced before using.
