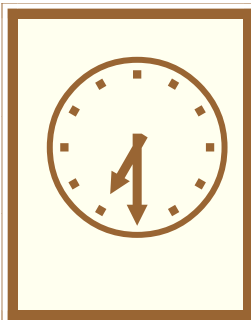

SPRING IS IN THE AIR ~ WALKERS, RUNNERS & CHILDREN ARE ON THE STREETS:

There are many walkers/runners and children on the streets with spring starting and warmer temperatures so we ask that you please slow down so we don't have an unfortunate accident in our neighborhood. For those that are interested, here is a guideline of the distance it is to walk/run from the clubhouse to different locations:

- Clubhouse parking lot to 4-way stop at Doeskin and Ranger Drive and back - 1.4 miles
- Clubhouse parking lot to I-10 by apartments on Doeskin and back - 2.2 miles
- Clubhouse parking lot down Doeskin to I-10 to end of Creekside Terrace on other side of Mission Pharmaceutical and back - 3.4 miles
- Clubhouse parking lot to the 4-way stop at Doeskin and Ranger Drive, then down Ranger Drive to I-10 and back - 2.8 miles

NOTE: To the cars that are coming home after dark: if you have your bright lights on and are passing a walker/runner, it blinds the person so please be considerate and turn your bright lights down.....and

Pool Rules:

1. Swim Badges must be worn at all times inside the pool area.
2. All persons using the pool do so at their own risk. The 2-person "buddy system" should be observed at all times.
3. Children under 12 are not permitted in the pool without adult supervision (18 years or older).
4. Only articles of clothing designed as swimming suits permitted in the pool ~ NO CUTOFFS!
5. No running or rough play inside the pool area. Food, drinks, chewing gum, smoking, chewing tobacco, snuff and/or glass containers are not allowed inside the pool area. No foul language on clubhouse facilities.
6. Only blow-up/sponge type balls (*no water guns or balloons*) are allowed in the pool area.
7. No dogs or pets allowed on clubhouse facilities.
8. The phone is for emergency use only, no exceptions.
9. Only 1 guest per homeowner's family is permitted *and* the homeowner MUST accompany that guest at all times. Board approval must be obtained before more guests will be permitted.
10. Homeowners **cannot** be guests of other homeowners.
11. Homeowner's dues must be current in order to utilize the associations' pool, tennis court, playground and clubhouse facilities.

NOTE: Replacement badges cost \$5 each.

Anyone breaking any of the above rules may loose their use of the pool for the summer and/or may result in law enforcement actions!!
