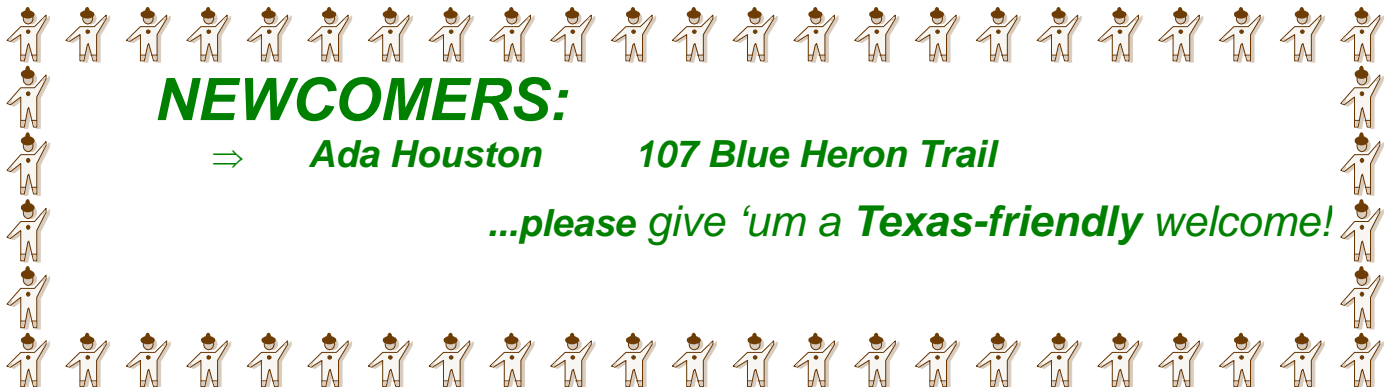
Fixing leaky faucets can save water and save you money. During seasonal summer drought conditions, it's vital to save water.

WATER WISDOM

Nobody likes a water waster, especially since it's such a waste of energy, too. The Alliance to Save Energy notes that with inevitable summer drought conditions, saving water could help save overall energy costs. Here are some combined water- and energy-saving tips that'll put less strain on water and energy resources, plus cut overall home utility bills:

- ⇒When purchasing a new washing machine or dishwasher, ask for appliances with the Energy Star label, a symbol of energy efficiency.
- ⇒Do full loads when you use clothes washers and dishwashers so that you use water and energy more efficiently.
- ⇒Use a low-flow showerhead - it saves up to 5 gallons a minute. Take shorter showers.
- ⇒Don't be a drip. Fix leaky faucets around the house. A leaky toilet can waste up to 52,800 gallons a year. Replace old aerators with newer models, which use less water and provide more water pressure.
- ⇒Place a plastic bottle filled with water in your toilet tank to save up to 11 gallons of water per day.
