

KNOW?

DRIVE CLEAN ACROSS TEXAS CAMPAIGN'S TIPS FOR REDUCING AIR POLLUTION:

- **Maintain you vehicle** per manufacturer's specifications so it runs better; make sure your tires are properly inflated to reduce drag on your engine; seal the gas cap tightly & refuel late in the day and don't top off the tank.
- **Buy a "clean" vehicle** - consider a low emissions model or hybrid; take advantage of tax credits by buying a hybrid car (epa.gov/greenvehicles has a list of cleanest vehicles)
- **Drive less by sharing rides:** combine your errands into one trip; walk/ride a bicycle instead of driving.
- **Drive the speed limit** - driving slower saves gas, which reduces tailpipe emissions; anticipate stops and coast to a stop gradually; accelerate and decelerate slowly and smoothly.
- **Idle less** - avoid waiting in drive-through lanes and unnecessary idling, park and go inside instead; leave earlier or later to avoid traffic and don't warm up your engine.
